The Hawaii Occupational Safety and Health Division (HIOSH) received a notice of health hazards at your worksite at 744 Front St, Lahaina. We notified you, by telephone, of these alleged hazards on March 28, 2002. The specific nature of the alleged hazards are as follows:

A written hazard communication program which at least describes how the criteria specified in paragraphs (f), (g), and (h) of this section for labels and other forms of warning, material safety data sheets, and employee information and training was not available. 29 CFR 1910.1200(e)(1) [Refer to Chapter 12-203.1, HAR].

We have not determined whether the hazards, as alleged, exist at your workplace and we do not intend to conduct an inspection at this time. However, since allegation of violations and/or hazards have been made, we request that you immediately investigate the alleged conditions and make any necessary corrections or modifications.

Please advise me in writing, no later than April 5, 2002, of the results of your investigation. You must provide supporting documentation of your findings, including any applicable measurements or monitoring results, and photographs/video which you believe would be helpful, as well as a description of any corrective action you have taken or are in the process of taking, including of the corrected condition. Please fax us your response if possible, addressed to Complaint Officer, at 586-9104. If your response is a lengthy one, you may fax a summarized response with the supporting documentation to follow by mail.
